Rules

Last month, ARC submitted a [proposal](#) to adjust the “Harmed” monster ability. Additional rituals have also been reviewed and either approved for a future ritual update or have been given feedback for the Design team to revise.

Technical

The Technical team is working diligently to incorporate important features into the CMA and AMS. The updated ritual text is now reflected in the live CMA. Additional tools for logistics teams are also actively being developed with the hopes of being deployed before the 2023 National event. The team is also looking for skilled React developers.

Diversity

The Alliance LARP Code of Ethics was submitted to the owners and is currently being voted on to incorporate as an official policy.

Design

Design has finalized and submitted over a dozen new ritual concepts to ARC, with many more in various states of completion. Progress is also being made on finalizing supporting documents and card generation for the updated 2.1 monster database. The team would also like to thank the larger Alliance playerbase for all of the feedback being submitted on the rulebook drafts.
